Ben Franklin Trust Fund

Selection Criteria:

- Students attending Pennsylvania College of Technology and enrolled full-time;
- Must be enrolled in an approved Tech Prep high school program and subsequently enroll in a Certificate, Associate's, or Bachelor's degree program at Pennsylvania College of Technology. In schools without approved Tech Prep programs, students must be enrolled in a high school vocational-technical program and subsequently enroll in a Certificate, Associate, or Bachelor's degree program at Penn College;
- Must have graduated from schools in counties that are served by the First Community Foundation Partnership of Pennsylvania's (Franklin Fund Service Area) Bradford, Clinton, Lycoming, Potter, Sullivan and Tioga;
- First-time applicants must have a grade point average of "B" or higher;
- Must submit a writing sample as defined by the Penn College Outreach for K-12 office;
- Preference given to continuing students in subsequent years if a cumulative GPA of 2.80 is maintained in the program;
- Preference is given to students in the Certificate and Associate degree programs.
